


Explore the vibrant contrasts of South Korea on a 13-day guided cultural and adventurous journey. From the imperial palaces of Seoul to the cultural towns of Busan and the coastal charm of Jeju Island, this tour blends deep heritage with modern wonder.

#### **DAY 1 - Departure from Malta**

Meet at Malta International Airport and depart for Seoul. Overnight is spent in flight.

#### **DAY 2 - Arrival in Seoul**

Arrive at Incheon International Airport and transfer to the hotel in Seoul. Spend the evening relaxing and enjoying dinner after your journey.

#### **DAY 3 - Seoul City Tour**

Explore Seoul, starting with Gwanghwamun Square, a central hub surrounded by historic landmarks, and Gyeongbokgung Palace, the grand royal palace of the Joseon Dynasty. Visit Bukchon Hanok Village to see traditional Korean houses, Insadong for cultural shopping and art galleries, and Jogyesa Temple, a major Buddhist site. End the day with a stroll along Cheonggyecheon Stream, a scenic urban waterway in downtown Seoul.

#### **DAY 4 - Excursion to the DMZ**

Take a guided visit to the Demilitarised Zone (DMZ), the border separating North and South Korea. Walk across Gamaksan Suspension Bridge for panoramic views of the surrounding mountains before returning to Seoul.

#### **DAY 5 - Travel to Gyeongju**

Depart Seoul and stop at Danyang for a cable car ride over Chungju Lake, offering stunning views of the water and surrounding landscape. Arrive in Gyeongju and check in to the hotel.

#### **DAY 6 - Gyeongju Exploration**

Discover Gyeongju's historic treasures, starting with Bulguksa Temple, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and Seokguram Grotto, home to a serene Buddha statue. Visit Daereungwon Tombs, royal burial grounds from the Silla Dynasty, and Yangdong Folk Village, a traditional village preserving Korean heritage. End the day at Donggung Palace and Wolji Pond, ideal for an evening stroll.

#### **DAY 7 - Travel to Busan**

Travel to Busan and visit Oryukdo Skywalk, a glass-bottomed walkway over dramatic cliffs, Haeundae Beach, and Camellia Island with its picturesque walking paths. Explore Centum City, a modern urban district known for striking architecture and shopping, before checking in to the hotel.

#### **DAY 8 - Busan Exploration**

Spend the day exploring Busan, starting with Gamcheon Culture Village, a colourful hillside village with artistic murals, and Jagalchi Market, Korea's largest seafood market. Take a ride on the Songdo Cable Car for panoramic views and enjoy Amnam Park's scenic urban trails. Return to the hotel in the evening.

#### **DAY 9 - Fly to Jeju Island**

Fly from Busan to Jeju Island. Begin exploring the island with Aewol Café Coast, known for trendy cafés and ocean views. Visit Osulloc Tea Plantation to wander through green tea fields and sample local tea, followed by Yongmeori Coast with dramatic cliffs and sea caves. See Cheonjiyeon Waterfall, a tranquil cascade surrounded by lush greenery, and Oedolgae Rock, an iconic coastal sea stack.

#### **DAY 10 - Jeju Nature & Culture**

Explore Hallasan National Park, home to South Korea's highest mountain and pristine hiking trails. Visit Mabang Pasture, a peaceful meadow with grazing horses, and Jeongbang Waterfall, one of the rare waterfalls that flows directly into the ocean.

#### **DAY 11 - Jeju Highlights**

Witness the sunrise at Seongsan Sunrise Peak, a volcanic crater rising above the sea and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Visit Seopjikoji Coast, a scenic headland with cliffs and ocean views, and the Haenyeo Museum to learn about Jeju's legendary female divers. Explore Manjanggul Cave, one of the world's longest lava tubes. In the evening, fly from Jeju to Seoul.

#### **DAY 12 - Seoul Cultural Tour**

In Seoul, visit the National Museum of Korea to explore its extensive collection of artefacts, Namsan for panoramic city views, and Namdaemun Market, a bustling traditional market. Shop and stroll through Myeongdong District and visit Myeongdong Cathedral, a historic Catholic church in central Seoul. Return to the hotel in the evening.

#### **DAY 13 - Seoul Modern Highlights & Departure**

Spend the morning exploring Gangnam District, famous for K-pop culture, and visit the Lotte World Tower with its 360° city views. Stroll around Seokchon Lake before collecting luggage and transferring to Incheon Airport for your departure flight.
